Actions and summary below:

Congratulations to the Green Team! The City was awarded a Maryland Municipal League achievement award for community engagement because of the Green Team's activities. The award will be presented to Malinda at the June convention in Ocean City.

Mt Rainier Nature Center Greening Fair on April 19, 10-2. The Green Team will have a booth on composting. I think we are in pretty good shape but if you'd like to volunteer let me know. For those of you who signed up to help, I will send a follow up email in the next few days with more details.

April 26 will be the Toolshed Native Plant sale and seed swap. Bryan Knedler is also doing a tree and history walk that day.

### Civic Center

We had the architect and LEED consultant for the Mt Rainier Civic Center project present the design and answer questions. We had a very robust discussion with the designers. The discussion focused on green design elements and doing more with energy (building envelope, roof solar), stormwater mitigation and low-maintenance landscaping. Currently the building is likely to meet LEED gold certification. As follow up the architect will be providing the contact for the engineer who did stormwater consulting for the project (Mike Plit). Brent will arrange a follow up meeting. Bill noted he has several follow up questions he'd like to send them. If others have questions for the design team, let me know by Friday, 4/18.
